Prior to animal being fostered a PATA officer will agree to meet with you at your home to discuss living arrangements and the terms of your fostering.

Note: All the above information will remain confidential to PATA.

Fostering terms and Conditions

PATA agrees to:

1. Provide the foster carer with animals to suit their level of competence.
2. Pay all veterinary bills regarding the fostered animals as long as the animals are treated by the agreed veterinary surgeon.
3. Provide any additional equipment to support the placement with the foster parents whenever possible.
4. Find homes for the fostered animals within the placement period or sooner as far as possible.
5. Offer alternative foster homes if the foster parents have trouble with the animal being fostered.
6. Offer only cats and dogs that are fully vaccinated and spayed/castrated if they are of appropriate age.
7. Provide emergency contact details for foster carer to contact PATA if needed.

The Fosterer agrees to:

1. To feed, house and care for the animal including providing adequate exercise and to only accommodate the animals at the agreed address. If they are moved PATA must be notified (and agree) prior to the move.
2. Observe all PATA guidelines with regards to animal health and welfare as stated in the Foster Care Manual, including to never permanently tether an animal, and respecting rules such as keeping cats indoors at all times.
3. Promptly report to PATA the condition of any animal giving cause for concern.
4. Allow PATA to visit and view the animals when required, whether routinely or when concerned about the welfare of any animal.
5. Allow members of the general public who are considering adopting an individual to view the animal at a mutually convenient time by arrangement through PATA, and following all adoption rules and regulations set out by PATA.
6. Provide PATA with up to date photo's of the animals in your care for the purposes of advertising.
7. If in an emergency it is necessary to use a vet other than the PATA agreed one, to inform PATA as soon as possible afterwards and PATA will cover all reasonable costs.
8. Obtain any necessary medical attention from the PATA veterinary and follow any instructions given by the veterinary surgeon regarding the health and welfare of any animal in their care.
9. Not allow any animal to be euthanized without the prior approval of PATA.
10. Provide receipts of any treatment needed or given.
11. Ensure that any equipment provided by PATA is well looked after. Any losses/thefts will be paid for by the fosterer at the discretion of PATA's Administrator.
12. That any damage/loss of equipment be reported as soon as possible to the PATA Administrator.

The Fosterer understands that:

1. PATA will endeavor to ensure that the animals are free from obvious diseases but that it cannot guarantee that this is the case. The fosterer should bear in mind the risks associated with caring for such animals.
2. In some cases where homes cannot be found, that euthanasia may be the only course of action. Any such action will only be taken by PATA and its veterinary surgeon.
3. The animals are and will remain the property of PATA and that the Fosterer will neither obtain nor claim any right of ownership nor title for the animal concerned, unless agreed with PATA.
